Moisture and mold go hand-in-hand. To remove mold from a property, the source of the moisture problem must be addressed. Timing is critical to the drying of a structure to prevent the growth of destructive mold and mildew. Therefore it is important to have trained and experienced technicians perform inspection, demolition, remediation and cleaning services.

GAINING CONTROL OF THE SITUATION

Emergency response teams are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Upon arrival, RMC's experienced staff will perform a thorough inspection using state-of-the-art thermal imaging cameras and moisture detection equipment. RMC contains the affected area(s) and establishes engineering controls before demolition, remediation procedures begin.

Mold Facts:

- Humidity >65% facilitates mold growth.
- Mold spores are microscopic and often airborne.

Reducing Secondary Mold Damage

Our team minimizes secondary damage by establishing negative pressurization and cross ventilation inside containments to avoid affecting other areas of the structure. Once remediation is complete, environmental testing is available to confirm the results of RMC's remediation efforts. To avoid conflicts of interest, the standard of care, the ANSI/IICRC S520 2015 Standard for Professional Mold Remediation, recommends that a third-party, independent Interior Environmental Professional (IEP) provide this service directly for the property owner. IEP services are normally included in your insurance claim.
